I will now declare the result of the election in the Ward 6 - East Kilbride South. There are 3 Councillors to be elected.

The electorate was 12,589 and the number of ballot papers received was 5,385 giving a percentage turnout of 42.8%. There were 111 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 1,319.
