I will now declare the result of the election in the Ward 9 - East Kilbride West. There are 3 Councillors to be elected.
The electorate was 13,319 and the number of ballot papers received was 6,779 giving a percentage turnout of $50.9 \%$. There were 70 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 1,678 .
