I will now declare the result of the election in the Ward 10 - East Kilbride East. There are 3 Councillors to be elected.

The electorate was 10,887 and the number of ballot papers received was 5,007 giving a percentage turnout of $46.0 \%$. There were 86 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 1,231 .
