Preliminary Report

For the introduction of a regulated car park

Location: Lanark Park and Ride car park, Lanark

Proposal: Introduction of a regulated car park

- Lanark Park and Ride car park, Lanark is situated to the south-east of Lanark High Street and is located off Ladyacre Road.
- 2. There are currently no restrictions within the Lanark Park and Ride car park.
- 3. Lanark Park and Ride car park forms part of the wider Lanark Interchange scheme which aims to improve transport infrastructure within Lanark.
 - The Park and Ride facility has been constructed on a site which previously contained two warehouses and an informal parking area. The new facility provides 64 spaces including 2 electric charging spaces. Misuse of these bays, by non-electric vehicles, would create issues for vehicles that require the use of the charging points.
- 4. It is therefore proposed to regulate Lanark Park and Ride car park where there are electric vehicle charging bays for the sole use of electric vehicles.
 - Parking vehicles outwith marked bays will also be prohibited.
- 5. The Chief Constable, Strathclyde Partnership for Transport and the Local Members have been consulted and have no objections to the proposals.

6. It is recommended, therefore that South Lanarkshire Council advertises its intention to make a Traffic Regulation Order introducing restrictions within Lanark Park and Ride car park, Lanark.


