

South Lanarkshire Council (Use of Off-street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2011, Amendment No. 1 Order 2024

On the 16 April 2024, South Lanarkshire Council made the above named Order, under the terms of the Road Traffic Act 1984, thereby amending the existing off street consolidation order to include Parkhall Street car park, East Kilbride.

The Order which comes into operation on the 3 June 2024, was advertised in the East Kilbride News in the week beginning the 15 December 2023. The effect of the order is as previously stated.

A copy of the Order and a map relative thereto are available for inspection on the council's website.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, by the 28 May 2024, apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.

Preliminary Report

For the amendment of details within an order

Location: The area of land situated to the east of Parkhall Street and west of numbers

39 to 133 Main Street, The Village, East Kilbride.

Proposal: To add the existing Parkhall Street car park order to another order.

- 1. The area of land to the east of Parkhall Street and west of numbers 39 to 133 Main Street, East Kilbride, is situated within the village area, to the north of East Kilbride Town Centre.
- 2. The existing regulations within Parkhall Street car park are to limit the use of this area to vehicles displaying a "Parkhall" permit issued to residents of number 39 to 133 Main Street, The Village, East Kilbride.
- 3. A review of recent orders highlighted that the order referring to Parkhall Street car park was not included in the most recent off street consolidation order.
- 4. Therefore, as a cleaning up exercise, it is proposed to add the existing order covering Parkhall Street car park to the existing off street consolidation order.
- 5. The Chief Constable, Strathclyde Partnership for Transport and the Local Members have been consulted and have no objections to the proposals.

6. I recommend, therefore that South Lanarkshire Council advertises its intention to make a Traffic Regulation Order amending the existing off street consolidation order to include Parkhall Street car park, East Kilbride.

South Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 35(1) and (3), 3(A), 35A and 35B and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following order.

- This order may be cited as "South Lanarkshire Council (Use of Off-street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2011, Amendment No. 1 Order 2024" and shall come into operation on the 3rd day of June 2024.
- 2. The order specified in schedule 1 to this order shall have the effect subject to the amendments specified in that schedule.
- 3. The Orders specified in Schedule 2 to this Order are hereby revoked.


