1. The total number of ballot papers counted in the referendum in the South Lanarkshire area is 222,927 (Two Hundred and Twenty Two Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty Seven).

The turnout is 85.3%.

2. The total number of votes cast in relation to each answer to the referendum question in this area is as follows:
