



**South Lanarkshire Council
(Disabled Persons' Parking Places) (No.3)
Order 2026**

South Lanarkshire Council propose to consider the introduction of a Traffic Regulation Order thereby introducing new regulated parking bays for the sole use of 'blue' badge holders on Boswell Drive, Blantyre; Helmsdale Court and McIntyre Terrace, both Cambuslang; Caneluk Avenue and Wilton Road, both Carluke; Main Street, Carnwath; Ash Place, Broom Crescent, Bryce Place, Darwin Road, Dawson Avenue, Glen More, Laburnum Avenue, Larch Court, Lyttleton, Munro Place, North Berwick Crescent, Sandpiper Place and Sinclair Place all East Kilbride; Hailstone Green and Ravenswood both Forth; Glenafton View, Kintore Park, Mary Street and West Wellbrae Crescent, all Hamilton; Kenilworth Road and Smiddy Court, both Lanark; Miller Street and Miller Street, both Larkhall; Drumilaw Way, Ellisland Crescent, Kingsacre Road, Reid Street, Tobermory Road, Trossachs Road, all Rutherglen.

Full details of these proposals, which form the proposed **South Lanarkshire Council (Disabled Persons' Parking Places) (No.3) Order 2026**, together with a plan and statement of reasons for proposing to make this Traffic Regulation Order, are available for inspection on the council's website.

Preliminary Report

For the Installation of Regulated Disabled Persons' Parking Bays

1. The locations of the disabled persons' parking bays, which are the subject of this proposal, are detailed in paragraph 7 below.
2. Currently there are no restrictions at these locations.
3. An assessment of a disabled person, living in the vicinity of each of the addresses detailed in paragraph 7, has shown that they are severely disadvantaged by not being able to park in the vicinity of their home.
4. It is proposed to restrict a short length of road, adjacent to the locations detailed below, to be used by a vehicle displaying a valid disabled person's badge only.
5. The Chief Constable, Strathclyde Partnership for Transport and the Local Members have been consulted and have no objections to the proposals.
6. It is therefore recommended, that South Lanarkshire Council advertises its intention to make a Traffic Regulation Order prohibiting waiting, except for disabled persons' badge holders, on a section of road adjacent to the properties detailed in paragraph 7 below.

**South Lanarkshire Council
(Disabled Persons' Parking Places)
(No.3) Order 2026**

South Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 45 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "South Lanarkshire Council (Disabled Persons' Parking Places) (No.3) Order 2026" and shall come into operation on.....
2. In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:-

"vehicle" unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads whether or not by mechanical power;

"disabled persons' badge" means:-

- (a) a badge issued under section 21 of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970,
- (b) a badge issued under a provision of the law of Northern Ireland corresponding to that section, or
- (c) a badge issued by any member State other than the United Kingdom for purposes corresponding to the purposes for which badges under that section are issued;

"disabled badge holder's permit" ("permit") means a badge or disc issued by the Council, in accordance with the provisions of this Order, to a holder of a valid disabled person's badge who has been allocated a disabled person's parking bay solely for their use, following consideration by a Council review panel".

"disabled persons' vehicle" means a vehicle lawfully displaying a disabled persons' badge;

"local authority" means a council constituted under section 2 of the Local Government etc. (Scotland) Act .

3. Parking Places for Disabled Persons' Vehicles

- (a) Each area of road which is described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby designated as a parking place.
- (b) The parking places designated in this Order shall only be used for the leaving of disabled person's vehicles displaying a valid disabled person's badge.
 - (i) When a parking place designated in this Order is for the exclusive use of a specific disabled badge holder, the parking places designated in this Order shall only be used for the leaving of disabled person's vehicles displaying a valid disabled person's badge and a disabled badge holder's permit with a unique permit identifier. The unique permit identifier must match the unique permit identifier shown either on the carriageway road marking legend, or on the upright sign indicating a parking place reserved only for a disabled badge holder or both.
- (c) The limits of the parking place designated in this Order and the limits of each parking bay in a parking place shall be indicated on the carriageway in such a manner as the local authority may determine by signs, carriageway markings, lines or other indications.
 - (i) When a parking place designated in this Order is for the exclusive use of a specific disabled badge holder issued with a disabled badge holder's permit, the unique permit identifier will be displayed either on the upright sign indicating a parking place reserved only for a disabled badge holder, after the carriageway road marking legend "DISABLED" or both.
- (d) Every vehicle left in a parking place designated in this Order shall so stand such that no bay is occupied by more than one vehicle and that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of a parking bay provided that, where the length of a vehicle precludes compliance with this paragraph, such vehicle shall be deemed to be within the limits of a parking bay if:-

- (i) the extreme front portion or, as the case may be, the extreme rear portion of the vehicle is within 300 mm of an indication on the carriageway provided under this Order in relation to the parking bay; and
 - (ii) the vehicle, or any part thereof, is not within the limits of any adjoining parking bay.
- (e) Any person duly authorised by the local authority or a police officer in uniform or parking attendant may move or cause to be moved in case of an emergency, to any place they think fit, vehicles left in a parking place.
- (f) Any person duly authorised by the local authority may suspend the use of a parking place or any part thereof whenever such suspension is considered reasonably necessary :-
- (i) for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
 - (ii) for the purpose of any building operation, demolition, or excavation in or adjacent to the parking place or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the parking place or the laying, erection, alteration, removal or repair in or adjacent to the parking place of any sewer or of any main, pipe, apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus, traffic sign or parking meter;
 - (iii) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place on any occasion of the removal of furniture from one office or dwelling house to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
 - (iii) on any occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any street will be thronged or obstructed; or
 - (v) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place at times of weddings or funerals or on other special occasions.
- (g) A police officer in uniform may suspend for not longer than twenty-four hours the use of a parking place or part thereof whenever such suspension is considered reasonably necessary for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety.

Boswell Drive	Blantyre	That part of the north-west side of Boswell Drive, which is bounded on the north-west side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 2 metres, and which extends from a point 18 metres north-east of the extended south-west gable of number 38-44 Boswell Drive, Blantyre, north-eastwards for a distance of 6 metres or thereby.

Annick Street	Cambuslang	That part of the west side of Annick Street, which is bounded on the west side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 6 metres, and which extends from a point 2 metres north of the extended north gable of number 52 Helmsdale Court, Cambuslang northwards for a distance of 2 metres or thereby.
McIntyre Terrace	Cambuslang	That part of the south side of McIntyre Terrace, which is bounded on the south side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 6 metres, and which extends from the extended east gable of number 3 McIntyre Terrace, Cambuslang westwards for a distance of 2 metres or thereby.
Caneluk Avenue	Carluke	That part of the west side of Caneluk Avenue, which is bounded on the west side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 2 metres, and which extends from a point 3 metres south of the extended south gable of number 31 Caneluk Avenue, Carluke, northwards for a distance of 6 metres or thereby.
Wilton Road	Carluke	That part of the north-west side of Wilton Road, which is bounded on the north-west side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 2 metres, and which extends from the extended south-west gable of number 207 Wilton Road, Carluke, north-eastwards for a distance of 6 metres or thereby.
Main Street	Carnwath	That part of the north side of Main Street, which is bounded on the north side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 2 metres, and which extends from a point 18 metres east of the extended west gable of number 91 Main Street, Carnwath, eastwards for a distance of 6 metres or thereby.
Ash Place	East Kilbride	That part of the north side of Ash Place, which is bounded on the north side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 6 metres, and which extends from a point 11 metres west of the extended east gable of number 36 Ash Place, East Kilbride westwards for a distance of 3 metres or thereby.
Broom Crescent	East Kilbride	That part of the south-east side of Broom Crescent, which is bounded on the south-east side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 6 metres, and which extends from the extended south-west gable of number 37 Broom Crescent, East Kilbride north-eastwards for a distance of 3 metres or thereby.
Bryce Place	East Kilbride	That part of the south-west side of Bryce Place, which is bounded on the south-west side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 6 metres, and which extends from a point 19 metres north-west of the extended south-east gable of number 30 Bryce Place, East Kilbride north-westwards for a distance of 3 metres or thereby.

Street	Town	Area of road designated as a parking place in South Lanarkshire
Darwin Road	East Kilbride	That part of the south side of Darwin Road, which is bounded on the south side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 6 metres, and which extends from a point 10 metres east of the extended east building line of number 36 Darwin Road, East Kilbride eastwards for a distance of 3 metres or thereby.
Dawson Avenue	East Kilbride	That part of the east side of Dawson Avenue, which is bounded on the east side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 2 metres, and which extends from a point 12 metres south of the extended north gable of number 58 Dawson Avenue, East Kilbride, southwards for a distance of 6 metres or thereby.
Glen More	East Kilbride	That part of the east side of Glen More, which is bounded on the east side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 6 metres, and which extends from the extended north building line of number 189 Glen More, East Kilbride southwards for a distance of 3 metres or thereby.
Laburnum Avenue	East Kilbride	That part of the north-east side of Laburnum Avenue, which is bounded on the north-east side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 6 metres, and which extends from a point 13 metres south-east of the extended north-west gable of number 60 Laburnum Avenue, East Kilbride, south-eastwards for a distance of 3 metres or thereby.
Larch Court	East Kilbride	That part of the north side of Larch Court, which is bounded on the north side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 6 metres, and which extends from a point 13 metres east of the extended west gable of number 61 Larch Court, East Kilbride, eastwards for a distance of 3 metres or thereby.
Lyttleton	East Kilbride	That part of the north-west side of Lyttleton, which is bounded on the north-west side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 3 metres, and which extends from a point 23 metres south-west of the extended north-east gable of number 72-74 Lyttleton, East Kilbride, south-westwards for a distance of 6 metres or thereby.
Munro Place	East Kilbride	That part of the south-east side of Munro Place, which is bounded on the south-east side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 3 metres, and which extends from a point 7 metres north-east of the extended south-west gable of number 7 Munro Place, East Kilbride, north-eastwards for a distance of 6 metres or thereby.
North Berwick Crescent	East Kilbride	That part of the north side of North Berwick Crescent, which is bounded on the north side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 3 metres,

Sinclair Place	East Kilbride	That part of the south side of Sinclair Place, which is bounded on the south side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 3 metres, and which extends from the extended west building line of number 2-8 Sinclair Place, East Kilbride, eastwards for a distance of 6 metres or thereby.
Hailstone Green	Forth	That part of the south-east side of Hailstone Green, which is bounded on the south-east side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 3 metres, and which extends from a point 2 metres north-east of the extended north-east gable of number 2-8 Hailstone Green, Forth, south-westwards for a distance of 6 metres or thereby.
Ravenswood	Forth	That part of the south-west side of Ravenswood, which is bounded on the south-west side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 3 metres, and which extends from a point 6 metres north-west of the extended south-east gable of number 41 Ravenswood, Forth, north-westwards for a distance of 6 metres or thereby.
Glenafton View	Hamilton	That part of the north side of Glenafton View, which is bounded on the north side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 6 metres, and which extends from a point 11 metres east of the extended west gable of number 1 Glenafton View, Hamilton, eastwards for a distance of 3 metres or thereby.
Kintore Park	Hamilton	That part of the north-east side of Kintore Park, which is bounded on the north-east side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 6 metres, and which extends from a point 14 metres south-east of the extended north-west gable of number 19 Kintore Park, Hamilton, south-eastwards for a distance of 3 metres or thereby.
Mary Street	Hamilton	That part of the south-west side of Mary Street, which is bounded on the south-west side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 3 metres, and which extends from the extended south-east gable of number 33 Mary Street, Hamilton, north-westwards for a distance of 6 metres or thereby.

Street	Town	Area of road designated as a parking place in South Lanarkshire
West Wellbrae Crescent	Hamilton	That part of the east side of West Wellbrae Crescent, which is bounded on the east side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 3 metres, and which extends from the extended north gable of number 64-68 West Wellbrae Crescent, Hamilton southwards for a distance of 6 metres or thereby.
Kenilworth Road	Lanark	That part of the south side of Kenilworth Road, which is bounded on the south side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 3 metres, and which extends from the extended east gable of number 34-36 Kenilworth Road, Lanark, westwards for a distance of 6 metres or thereby.
Smiddy Court	Lanark	That part of the west side of Smiddy Court, which is bounded on the west side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 3 metres, and which extends from a point 3 metres north-west of the extended south gable of number 2 Smiddy Court, Lanark, north-westwards for a distance of 6 metres or thereby.
Miller Street	Larkhall	That part of the north side of Miller Street which is bounded on the north side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 2 metres, and which extends from a point 41 metres east of the extended west gable of number 56 Miller Street, Larkhall, eastwards for a distance of 6 metres or thereby.
Miller Street	Larkhall	That part of the south side of Miller Street, which is bounded on the south side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 3 metres, and which extends from a point 44 metres west of the extended east gable of number 83 Miller Street, Larkhall westwards for a distance of 6 metres or thereby.
Drumilaw Way	Rutherglen	That part of the east side of Drumilaw Way, which is bounded on the east side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 6 metres, and which extends from a point 17 metres south of the extended north gable of number 10 Drumilaw Way, Rutherglen, southwards for a distance of 3 metres or thereby.
Drumilaw Way	Rutherglen	That part of the east side of Drumilaw Way, which is bounded on the east side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 6 metres, and which extends from a point 25 metres north of the extended south gable of number 14 Drumilaw Way, Rutherglen, northwards for a distance of 3 metres or thereby.
Ellisland Crescent	Rutherglen	That part of the north-west side of Ellisland Crescent, which is bounded on the north-west side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 3 metres, and which extends from a point 10 metres north-east of the extended south-west gable of number 24 Ellisland Crescent, Rutherglen, north-eastwards for a distance of

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		6 metres or thereby.
Kingsacre Road	Rutherglen	That part of the south side of Kingsacre Road, which is bounded on the south side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 3 metres, and which extends from a point 3 metres east of the extended east gable of number 302-304 Kingsacre Road, Rutherglen, westwards for a distance of 6 metres or thereby.
Reid Street	Rutherglen	That part of the south side of Reid Street, which is bounded on the south side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 3 metres, and which extends from a point 3 metres east of the extended east gable of number 8 Reid Street, Rutherglen, westwards for a distance of 6 metres or thereby.
Reid Street	Rutherglen	That part of the south side of Reid Street, which is bounded on the south side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 3 metres, and which extends from a point 6 metres east of the extended west gable of number 14-16 Reid Street eastwards for a distance of 6 metres or thereby.
Tobermory Road	Rutherglen	That part of the north-east side of Tobermory Road, which is bounded on the north-east side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 3 metres, and which extends from a point 10 metres north-west of the extended south-east gable of number 2 Tobermory Road, Rutherglen, north-westwards for a distance of 6 metres or thereby.
Trossachs Road	Rutherglen	That part of the south-west side of Trossachs Road, which is bounded on the south-west side by the edge of carriageway, which has a width throughout of 3 metres, and which extends from a point 1 metre south-east of the extended north-west gable of number 26 Trossachs Road, Rutherglen, south-eastwards for a distance of 6 metres or thereby.

Statement of Reasons

It is considered necessary to make the above Order to improve the amenity of the area and comply with current legislation.

The Disabled Persons' Parking Places (Scotland) Act 2009 which came into effect on the 1 October 2009 requires all local authorities to identify any new and existing advisory disabled street parking places and, to promote orders to regulate them.
