A South Lanarkshire Leisure and Culture Gold Card gives talented sports people free use of a wide range of sports facilities.

Am I entitled to a Gold Card?

You are entitled to a Gold Card if you live in South Lanarkshire* and are:

- A sports person who is a full member of a first national team or squad.
- Competing as an individual who has been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in a Scottish or United Kingdom level 'open championship' Please note Masters competitions/events are not eligible.
- A current coach to a first national team or squad accompanying an athlete in a coaching role (this can only be used to access facilities to coach an athlete - not for personal use).

Which facilities can be used?

With a Gold Card you can use all sports centres and swimming pools operated by South Lanarkshire Leisure and Culture or North Lanarkshire Leisure*, subject to the following conditions:

- With the exception of swimming pool (not sauna/steam room), gym and athletic tracks use, you can only use the facilities associated with your sport.
- Court hire a non-card holder playing with a Gold Card holder pays half of the court hire. If four play, the three non-cardholders pay for three-quarters of the court hire. One court (max 1 hour) can be reserved in advanced each week by a Gold Card holder. Two Gold Card holders booking consecutive courts get one hour free and pay for the second hour. If courts are not booked in advance the Gold Card holders can play free of charge.

How long is a Gold Card valid?

A Gold Card is valid for one year, from the date of achievement, as long as you remain a member of a national team or squad, placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd at a current Scottish or United Kingdom 'open championship'. South Lanarkshire Leisure and Culture reserves the right to suspend the scheme at any time and without warning. Gold Card athletes will be expected to support and promote sport in South Lanarkshire by attending events/festivals up to twice a year.

How do I get a Gold Card?

You will need to:

- Complete part A of the form in this leaflet.
- Get an official of the national governing body of your sport to complete part B of the form.
- For security and re-validation purposes, the applicant must agree to have his/her photograph taken by SLLC staff. Failure to agree to this will result in access being denied.

All applicants require approval by the a Development Officer who may, if required, contact you or your national governing body for more information. Your card will be posted to you.
