- Your library barcode and PIN
- A PC, Mac, tablet, ipad or smartphone which is connected to the internet
- For PCs and Macs: Adobe digital editions
- For ipad/iphone: Adobe bluefire app
- For android devices: Aldiko app

Getting started

Step 1 – Register your library barcode to create an ebook account at <http://slc.libraryebooks.co.uk>





Step 6 – download. Once your items are processed, which will take a few minutes you can go to **manage loans/reservations** where you can download your selected titles to your PC, Mac or other device.



Step 7 – read. Your title will appear in your Adobe digital editions bookshelf.



You can now either read the title on your PC/Mac or you can copy it to your ebook reader.



SLLC Ebook facts

1. You will need to set up an Adobe ID in order to use this service
2. You can download titles from your PC or Mac to an ebook reader using Adobe digital editions. Check the instruction manual of your ebook reader for more information
3. All our titles are protected by DRM (digital rights management). Check that your ebook reader can open DRM material in epub or pdf format
4. You may borrow up to 6 titles at once
5. You may not return a title early due to publishing restrictions
6. If a title is not available for loan, you can reserve it
